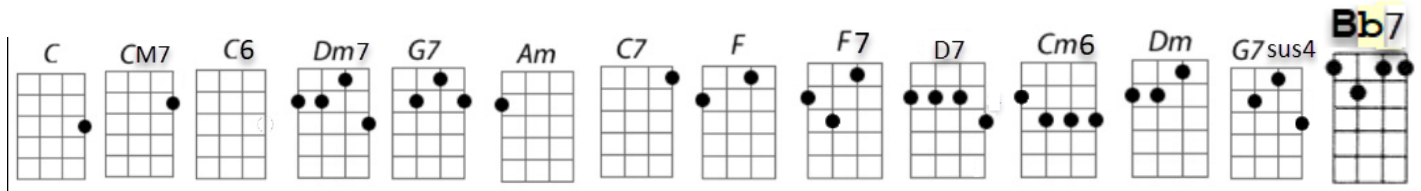


Baby It's Cold Outside – Frank Loesser
